Math Fact Fluency

Is your child still using his/her fingers to add, subtract, multiply, or divide? It is important your child has a solid foundation with addition, subtraction as well as multiplication/division.

Please encourage your child to work on fluency and accuracy without using fingers. Here are a few ways to practice addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division.

- 7 Flash cards-You can make your own flash cards or buy them at the Dollar Tree. Place the cards in different areas of your home. When your child sees the card, he/she gives the answer.
- 7 Number Cubes (also called dice by some people)-Roll the two number cubes together to add, subtract, multiply, or divide. If you need two-digit numbers, roll the number cubes twice. Number cubes can be found at the Dollar Tree. You can get a pack of 5 or 6 for \$1.00.
