<u>Reading</u>

Students will refer to parts of stories, dramas, and poems when writing or speaking about a text, using terms such as chapter, scene, and stanza. They will describe how each part builds on earlier sections.

Writing

Students will work on informational writing.

- Students will find the area and perimeter of quadrilaterals and rectilinear figures.
- Students will solve problems involving area and perimeter of polygons.

<u>Social Studies</u>

- Students will explain how location impacts supply and demand and how locations of resources influence economic development.
