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
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## EOG Math Work

Mrs. Mitchell and Ms. Hotaling have bought a **green binder** for each child. Your child will use this binder for EOG math practice and EOG reading practice! **Please remind your child that only EOG practice items should be in this binder.**

Each night your child will receive math review problems that should be solved each night and returned to school the next day.

Please remind your child to **complete only the problems that are listed in their planners and to not go ahead** as other problems will be scheduled in the future. Also, please remind your child to show **ALL WORK** and to attempt each problem, even if unsure as to how to solve.

We will discuss these problems in class daily. Therefore, please make sure the binder is **returned each day** so your child is prepared for the daily math discussion.

Each night please review the work with your child and have them practice skills they missed. **All work should stay in the binder--in the order it was assigned.** Math assignments should stay in the math section, and reading assignments should stay in the reading section.

**If your child loses his/her binder, please provide a replacement binder.** Thank you for your help.

Reading EOG practice will be sent home later. You will receive notice when reading begins.
