Curriculum

Reading

Students will ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of fictional text and refer to the text for evidence based answers. They will continue to establish independent reading habits and work on beginning of year assessments.

Writing

Students will work on narrative writing.

Math

Students will fluently add and subtract within 1,000 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.

<u>Social Studies</u>

Students will understand the three branches of government, with an emphasis on local government. They will also describe the structure of local government and how it functions to serve citizens.
